Murray State University Athletic Training Program Upcoming Costs

This document is to inform you of some upcoming costs associated with admittance into the Athletic Training Program. These costs are **mandatory and non-refundable** once the order is placed.

\$15.00	Student Professional Liability Insurance (renewed annually in April) – Students must maintain PLI throughout the course of their clinical experiences.
\$10.00	Racer Card Office – one time charge, unless you lose your nametag
\$100.00	One-year membership to the NATA (must remain a member during ALL Clinical Experience courses) – due first day of the spring semester You can become a member here: http://www.nata.org/join-nata
\$10.00	TB Skin Test – This cost may be \$0 if we get it from Health Services.
\$20.00	Flu Vaccinations – This may be required for specific clinical sites.
\$35.00	CPR/AED/First Aid Re-Certifications (pocket mask required) every 2 yrs. Students can complete the EXS 295 course for initial certifications (with a pocket mask included in the course pack), but must have a pocket mask for subsequent re-certifications.
Depends	Spring Clothing Package (last year \$30 for a polo + \$10 for a t-shirt) The Program only requires ATSs to purchase one polo and one t-shirt for the academic year. Many students purchase other attire (not required to complete clinical experiences), such as: rain suits (\$100), t-shirts (\$10-15), long-sleeve t-shirts (\$15), sweatshirts (\$30), etc. These purchases are solely your decision. The AT Program does have a dress code, which should be followed. You may need to purchase longer shorts, t-shirts, khakis, and polos for appropriate dress at the clinical sites.
Recommended Personal "Fanny" Packs/Kits (\$35 last year). You are not required

to purchase a Fanny Pack; however, many ATSs find that the use

of a pack is a necessity.

Recommended MSATA (student organization) – approximately \$15 per semester

Future Criminal Background Check – currently our clinical sites do not require Criminal Background Checks; however, as we search for new clinical sites at local hospitals and school districts, these checks may become required.
