***Project set-up** - Upon arrival, students with projects will set them up in the **Large Ballroom** on the tables designated by language. (Varsity-level tables will also be designated.)

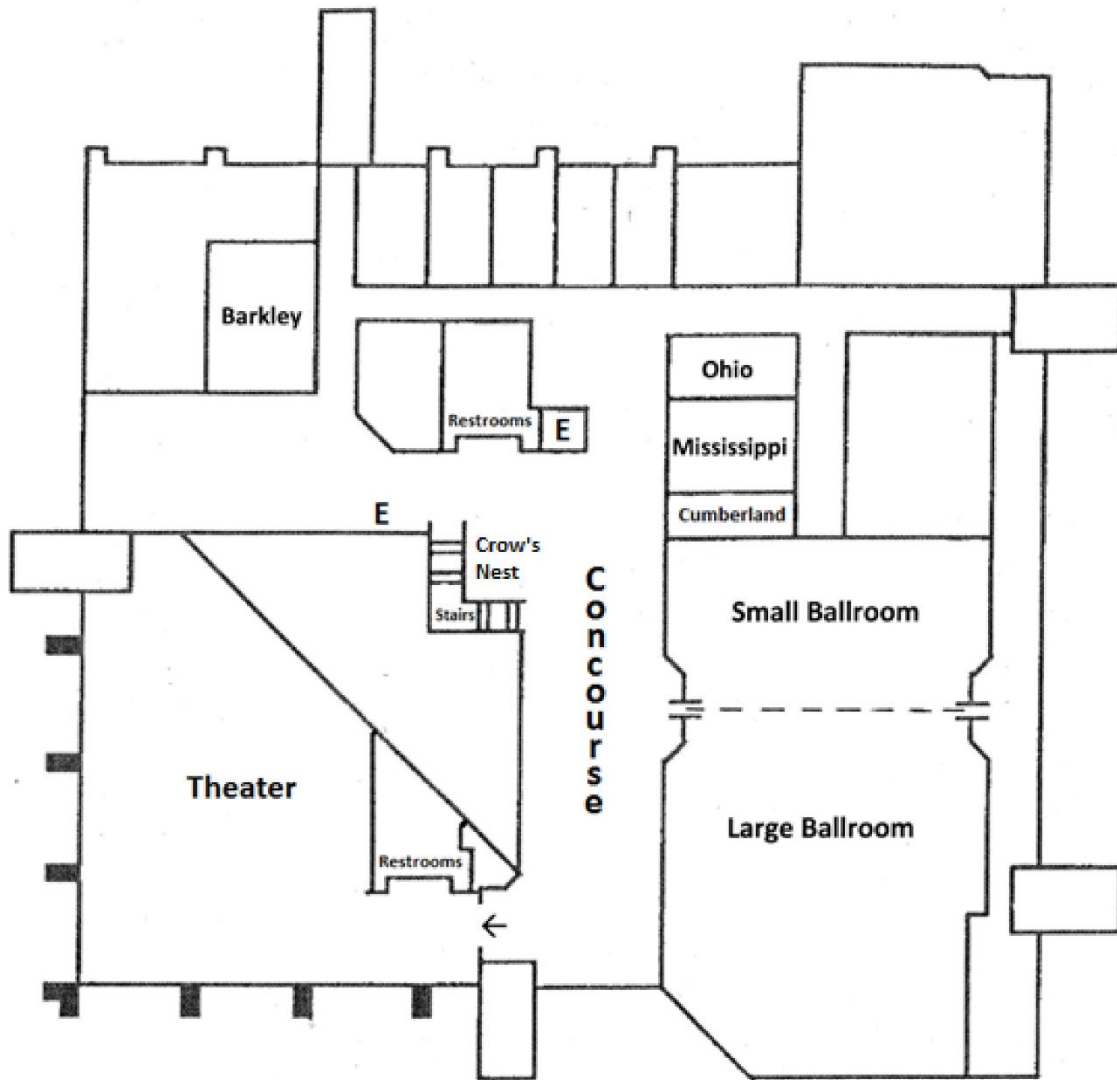
