Murray State University Strategic Plan: Achievement, Endeavor and Hope

Major Achievements in 2015-2016

- Increase STEM-H degrees awarded by 10% to correspond with CPE guidelines
In FY15, we had 825 graduates and in FY16 to date we have 1036. (This is a 25.6% increase!)
- Enhance academic aspects by increasing average composite ACT from 22.6 to 25 for unconditionally admitted students.
In Fall 2015, composite ACT average was 22.9.
- Increase transfer and articulation agreements from 126 to no less than 130.
In FY16, we already have 132 agreements!
- Increase private funds raised annually to \$6 million in FY15 and increase by 5% each subsequent year.
On June 30, 2016, we had \$5.8 million. This was a 47% increase over the previous year!
- Review admission standards and implement changes as necessary to ensure student pathways of success.
The Board of Regents voted on this and the implementation started Fall 2016.
- Develop an effective tuition and scholarship model.
This was developed and endorsed by the CPE and our Board of Regents in Spring 2016.
- Develop and promote a University Master Calendar.
This was completed January 8, 2016! The new calendar had been accessed more in 4 months (44,409 times) than the entire year prior.
