OSP Spotlight

Drs. Kevin Miller and Daniel Johnson

National Science Foundation

Drs. Kevin Miller and Daniel Johnson recently were awarded an MRI (Major Research Instrumentation) grant from the National Science Foundation in the amount of \$147,455 to purchase a DHR-2 Discovery Hybrid Rheometer for the Department of Chemistry. The rheometer will provide real-time and post-cure rheological analysis of polymers, solutions, fluids, resins and other soft materials. Potential applications for the materials which will be analyzed using this instrumentation include gas/ion separation devices, microfluidics and 3D printing. The instrument will support a current NSF-funded research program in the Department of Chemistry and several courses between the Department of Chemistry and the Institute of Engineering. The instrumentation will also facilitate an active collaboration with Estron Chemical, Inc and enable similar relationships with other local chemical R&D/manufacturing facilities. Specific projects that will be enhanced by the acquisition of the proposed rheometer include the elucidation of in situ and post-cure rheological properties of poly(ionic liquid) networks (PILs) prepared by thiolene/yne click photochemistry, the determination of dielectric properties of these PIL networks, exploration of dynamic polymeric systems and the analysis of resins for 3D printing.

A wide variety of projects will be directly impacted through the purchase of this instrument in both departments and help to facilitate a growing interest between the departments in 3D printing. Outcomes from research conducted with the rheometer will be disseminated in the form of peer reviewed publications and student presentations. The students who utilize this instrumentation, whether it be through research or coursework, will be better prepared than their counterparts at similarly sized institutions in the region. The rheometer, in addition to the equipment already present in the Polymer and Material Characterization Laboratory (second floor, Jones Hall), will be used to attract new students to MSU, in particular to the Polymer and Materials Science degree track.
