

# Other Recommendations

- Establish Greek Standards Benchmark Award.
- Implement a Public Greek Standards Benchmark Scorecard.
- Assess a Greek Fee of \$10 per semester (per member) to cover the cost of educational programming, leadership components, social event software, etc.). Failure to pay will result in non-attendance at social events.
- Update the Social Event Policy that is visually appealing and easier to read, including a social media campaign.

# Other Recommendations

- Non-alcoholic beverage equation based on the number of guests in attendance (provided on the social event registration form) – One beverage per attendee (total of chapter members and guests).
  - Registration Form should also include the type of non-alcoholic beverage and snacks that will be provided by host chapter.
- Living quarters should be limited to beer only.
- Informational Session should be held with Housing Corporations and Advisors at the beginning of each academic year.

# Other Recommendations

- A program to educate chapter officers about Host Liability Education should be held each year.
- Each chapter should have a Faculty Fellow (non-affiliated faculty/staff scholarship advisor).
- University training provided to advisors, enabling them to understand their responsibilities.
- At all Summer Orientations, Question and Answer Sessions should be brought back to address issues of risk management, educational requirements and expectations of Greek Life.

# Other Recommendations

- Advisor Support/Communication
  - **RECOMMENDATION:**
    - Include Housing Corporation on any communication dealing with social events.
    - Advisors should be informed of which organizations are in trouble or are experiencing problems so that other advisors can council their chapters accordingly.

# Other Recommendations

- Advisor Support/Communication (continued): Regular advisor's meetings should be held to discuss problems and solutions
  - Advisors who do not attend will cause their chapter's social privileges to be suspended (Extraordinary circumstances will be taken into consideration).
  - National Headquarters should be notified when advisors are not present for meetings.
    - » If applicable, Housing Corporations should also be notified.
