Dr. Bob Jackson (President of Murray State University):

- We are working on getting back to normal for next semester.
 - o It is dependent on CDC guidelines and state guidelines on the rules about masks.

- Vaccinations:
 - o 10,000 vaccinations given at the CFSB center thus far.
 - o Vaccines are not required but strongly encouraged. You really cannot mandate the vaccines because they are not fully approved by the FDA.
- How to make next semester normal:
 - o We hope to have 70% of students vaccinated. If we get to 70%, the restrictions will be removed per Governor Beshear. We hope to improve CFSB capacity from 15% to 50% or more. We hope to make masks more optional. Classroom capacity will be changed. Zoom classrooms will only be if you choose to do so. The biggest factor in making the semester more normal is getting vaccinated.
