What is RACR?

- RACR stands for Racer Academic Completion Report
- The Degree Works software is a powerful tool that fully integrates with the Banner student system to offer students and advisors the ability to track degree progress, prepare for registration, and plan for graduation
- RACR is designed to aid and facilitate academic advising
- Students must have a complete RACR in order to graduate



Accessing the RACR

- Students: Currently enrolled undergraduate, first-time degree seeking students
- Coming soon: graduate students!
- Faculty/Staff: All Murray State personnel who are listed as Faculty or Advisor in Banner may have access to RACR

Accessing the RACR



Student Search:

- Current students
- Shows other helpful information
- Directly links to that student's RACR

Links (under Teaching/Advising tab):

- Helpful when looking for non-current students
- Directs to user information/error; use "Find" icon
- Alternative ways to search for students



- 2. Enter a student's M# into the Student ID field and press enter on your keyboard.







RACR and Banner

Reading the RACR

Each audit consists of a series of blocks

- Green check marks mean that a requirement is satisfied
- Blue tildes mean that the requirement is in progress and should be satisfied after course work is successfully completed
- Open red check boxes mean that the requirement has not yet been satisfied
- Unmet conditions





Print/Save as PDF and Class History



Use the Class History feature to view a semester by semester breakdown of the student's course work.






Why use the What If feature?

- To hypothesize a change in major.
- 2. To temporarily compensate for data missing in Banner.
 - Viewing an audit what for a minor that had not yet been declared
 - Viewing an audit with a concentration that has not been declared

NOTE: You must select ALL the criteria you want to see in the What If audit (ie: Degree, Catalog Year, Major, Minor).

- Audits update nightly


